For purposes of the Trip Cancellation benefit, the Terrorist Incident must occur within 30 days of your scheduled departure date in either your scheduled trip departure city or in a city listed on the scheduled itinerary of your trip (or within 30 miles of either location). Please note that coverage will not apply if you are offered a substitute itinerary or if a Terrorist Incident occurred in the same foreign city within 90 days prior to the date you purchased your plan. Alternatively, Trip Cancellation coverage may apply if you are called to active military duty or emergency service as a firefighter or police officer either to serve or to provide aid and relief in the event of a Terrorist Incident.
